The Altuglas® Bath&Shower Range includes 4 qualities of sheets developed for various sanitary applications:

- > **Altuglas® CS:** Grade for all sanitaryware applications
- > **Altuglas® CS: Easy Forming:** Grade with a higher thermoformability for deep or complex models.
- > **Altuglas® CS: Easy Machining:** Grade for vertical applications with a higher flexibility
- > **Altuglas® Sanitized:** Grade with a built-in-antimicrobial protection

Each grade can be produced in 3 different finishes:

- > **Glossy:** for a high quality gloss aspect
- > **Satin:** for an upper matt aspect
- > **Shadow:** for a colour graduation aspect

Standard protection

The standard protection for all grades of **Altuglas® Bath&Shower Range** is a clear thermoformable film on the top face of the sheet, the other face is not protected. The Altuglas® sheets with satin finish are protected by a non-thermoformable film on the top. Other protection is considered as non-standard.



Sizes

The standard dimension of Altuglas sheets is 3060 x 2060 and 3085 x 1820 mm. All types of the standard range can be delivered cut to size. Untrimmed sheets are considered as standard sheets.

Altuglas International offers a choice of 250 complementary colours, as well as the possibility to create and develop new colours (colour matching)

This material has been specially designed for the manufacturing of high quality bathtubs, shower trays and other sanitary appliances.

Altuglas® sheets meet the European EN 263 standard used to manufacture sanitary ware. In addition, Altuglas® sheets manufactured at St Avold in France received official certification from AFNOR (Association Française de Normalisation) in October 1991, enabling them to use the NF label.
